

However, winners of all events will be determined by having flyoffs at 3 p.m. Cat. II Flyoff Rules—All classes: 3-minute launch window. First flyoff flight is 4 minute max. Each additional flight is increased by 1 minute. All motor runs are 7 seconds. Cat. III—Flyoffs start at 3 p.m. as per Cat. III rules.

PRIZES:

Guaranteed prizes through third in each event. (Re-entry allowed in Open Gas with different class engine.) Vouchers of equal value may be taken in lieu of prizes and accumulated for more valuable prizes.
